

GE ATRC – Aviation Training Center Emergency Notification Call Tree






VISITING QATAR SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY PARK

This pamphlet explains how to arrange your visit, directions to QSTP, and what to do once you arrive.

ARRANGING YOUR VISIT

CSTP is not a public sea, and visits must be amanged in advance

On Arrival to CSTP gateriouse visitors will be required to bresent a valid photo ID. (Octair ID: Octair criving ligense, Company IO or Pasaport).



DIRECTIONS

From the Corniche,

- Take Khalifa St. to Education City (via Al Lugis St., A. Merkhiya roundabout and immigration Tiyover).
- 2. At titted/sloping roundabout turn right
- 8. At the first roundabout (Gharrata) make a U-turn
- 4. Take the second right, which is the entrance to QSTP.
- 5. After cleaning the galehouse, go streight ahoud to the appropriate can park



GENERAL INFORMATION

This brochure provides general information that will help you during your stay at the GE Advanced Technology and Research Centre. If you have questions that are not answered here, please do not hesitate to ask any GE ATRC Aviation Training Centre personnel.

Currency

The official currency is the Qatari Riyals (QR), which is divided into 100 Dirhams. The exchange parity has been set at a fixed rate of US\$1=QR3.64.

Climate

The country has a moderate desert climate with hot summers and mild winters. Winter nights can be cool, but temperatures rarely drop below 7 degree Celsius.

Temperature and humidity rise in Coastal cities and town during summer.

Rainfall is scarce, falling on isolated days mainly between October and March.

Public Transportation System

Transportation to the training center can be arranged by the Hotel where you will be staying at. All local transportation from the hotel or place in Doha is at your own expense. Note: Doha is a small city and taxi is available at a reasonable price.

<u>Attendance Policy:</u> 80% attendance of each class is required. You will be given a Training Certificate once you have completed the training course.

Class Times and Schedule

Your class schedule will be provided to you during orientation on your first day of class.
Classes begin at 8:00 AM until 3:00 PM.

Student Badges

On your first day of class, you will receive the appropriate badges which must be worn at all times while you are in the QSTP areas. Those badges will allow you to travel unescorted to your classroom, the cafeteria, restrooms, break room and the bay on the shop floor. Travel to other parts of the building or other QSTP areas will require a GE escort. On your last day of class, it is important that you return all badges to the Security Officer or Training Administrator in the front lobby.

Parking

If you are driving to class, free parking is available at the GE ATRC Car park.

Cameras

If you need to photograph your training engine, ask your Instructor or the Aviation Training Administrator for a camera pass form. All requests are subject for approval. Cell phone photo is allowed but videos are prohibited.

Food Services

Access to the Cafeteria will be given to students. Coffee vending machines are located in the break area. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the premises of GE ATRC. Eating is not permitted on the shop floor.

Smoking

Smoking is permitted only in designated smoking areas. No tobacco product use is allowed inside of the facility.

First Aid Services

Limited medical attention is available at GE ATRC. Our first aid staff may refer you to a private physician, dentist or to a local hospital. Be aware that if you see a private doctor or dentist or enter a hospital, it will be at your personal expense. Please inform your instructor if you need medical attention during class or if you are ill and cannot come to class.

Passports/Visas

If you are a visitor from another country, carry your passport at all times while you are in the State of Qatar.

As of September 2010, Visa is issued upon arrival for citizens of 33 countries such as Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UK, USA and Vatican. For those trainees requiring prearranged Visa, refer to your Company PRO or contact the Ramada Plaza who can also arrange the visa. (2011 rates apply).

Training Material

GE will provide training materials in CD format containing all appropriate information.

Safety Rules

The following is a list of general and specified rules that <u>everyone</u> must follow. Remember that <u>everyone</u> is expected to know the rules. If you don't know the proper procedures, please ask your instructor.

1. Listen carefully when your instructor provides safety and environmental health information during your orientation and throughout your classes.

Safety Rules (continued)

- 2. Read the Environmental Health and Safety policy on page 2 of this booklet.
- 3. Review the general shop practices listed at the end of this booklet.
- 4. Ask any safety/environmental health questions you may have.
- 5. Be aware of safety instructions before:
 - performing maintenance of equipment
 - operating equipment or machinery
 - using material or equipment which you have not used before.
- 6. Refer to your copy of the Chemical Product Information Training for the GE ATRC-Aviation Training Centre students, as needed.
- 7. Comply with posted safety rules in specific areas, whether working in or passing through an area.
- 8. Know the evacuation plan for your work area.
- 9. Report any unsafe conditions immediately to your instructor.
- 10. Identify eye wash stations, showers and the MSDS book location.
- 11. For life-threatening emergency, dial 44540999

Note: Items 6-11 will be discussed during the orientation.



Safety Rules (continued)

- 12. All GE ATRC employees and visitors inside engine bay where shop work is being performed must wear safety glasses. GE ATRC employees and visitors not performing shop work do not require safety glasses unless they enter an engine bay/work area where shop work is being performed.
- 13. At a minimum, substantial footwear is required by all individuals who enter the shop. Substantial footwear is defined as a shoe that completely encloses the wearer's foot. Thongs, Flip-flops, clogs, sandals and similar footwear are **not allowed**. All employees, contractors and visitors who are performing work must wear approved safety shoes. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in removal from the shop area.
- 14. Do not eat, drink or smoke in the shop floor.
- 15. Report all injuries and illnesses immediately to your instructor prior to going to First Aid for treatment.
- 16. Removal of guards or safety interlocks can only be done under the supervision of the instructor.
- 17. Report any electrical equipment and machinery that is not grounded.
- 18. DO NOT operate any mobile plant equipment.
- 19. Upon the event of a hazardous material spill, no matter how small it is always notify your instructor.





ENGINE MAINTENANCE PRACTICES FOR SHOP CLASSES

- 1. Follow all environmental health and safety directions and rules.
- 2. Return tools and fixtures to their designated storage place right after use.
- 3. Do not disfigure the engine.
- 4. Do not stand on the top hand rails of work stands.
- 5. Do not leave loose tools on the engine, floor or work stands.
- 6. Give ample warning before moving suspended loads.
- 7. Do not use force to remove or install engine parts.
- 8. Only one person will give hoist operator instructions.
- 9. Perform maintenance work on the shop floor only when an instructor is present.

- 10. Last fifteen minutes of the class day:
 - Place hand tools in proper boxes.
 - Return hand tool cabinets to designated storage area.
 - Return fixtures to designated area and align in an orderly manner.
 - Clean area around engine/module.
